## ABOUT

An all-round exciting white blend, named after the famous Observatory built by the Jesuit founding fathers of Château Ksara.

## GRAPE VARIETIES

Clairette, Muscat and Sauvignon Blanc.

## WINEMAKING

Hand-picked and pressed in whole bunches before fermentation after which the wine is bottled.

## AROMAS & FLAVORS

A light and fresh, fruit-driven and floral wine, in which the fullness is derived from the Clairette; the aroma from the Muscat; the vigor and freshness from the Sauvignon.

## PAIRING

It can be enjoyed alone or served with seafood, salads, Lebanese appetizers and goat cheese. Serve lightly chilled.

## DRINKING WINDOW

Blanc de L'Observatoire should be drunk within three years of the vintage.
